What voltage should an inverter be plugged into?

Always match your inverter's voltage to your battery bank. Mixing voltages without proper converters can damage your system. Charge Controllers: MPPT controllers are more efficient at 24V and 48V. Breakers/Fuses: Use DC-rated versions sized for voltage and current. AC Output: Remains 110V or 120V regardless of DC input voltage.

Is a 24 volt battery converter worth it?

A 24 volt system is a good compromise. 24 to 12 volt converters are cheap and efficient. 48 to 12 volt units are also available for a decent price. I have one on my battery bank that can supply 25 amps of 12 volt power, that is a solid 300 watts.

My simple rule of thumb is to try and keep the system under 100 amps during normal operation. 12 volts to 1,200 watts, 24 volts to 2,400 watts, and 48 volts to 4,800 watts. ...
