The website is managed by the Australian Mobile Telecommunications Association on behalf of the Mobile Carriers Forum.

The recently said that it aims to cover 75% of the country's population with its 5G service by June 2021. In the past few months, Telstra deployed its 5G technology in the Sunshine Coast in Queensland, along with parts of New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia and Western Australia.

Where in Australia does Telstra offer 5G?

When does 5G start in Australia?
