BESS facilities are a specific type of energy storage system that store energy using batteries. Considerations for zoning must consider their intended use, preferred location and size.

#### How much energy storage does Canada need?

Canada's current installed capacity of energy storage is approximately 1 GW. Per Energy Storage Canada's 2022 report, Energy Storage: A Key Net Zero Pathway in Canada, Canada is going to need at least 8 - 12 GW to ensure the country reaches its 2035 goals.

#### Will Bess be overtaken by a 500 MW project?

Ontario's electric grid operator, the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO), has awarded contracts for what will be the largest battery energy storage projects (BESS) in Canada, at 390 MW and 380 MW. However, they could soon be overtaken by a proposed 500 MW project that is slated to come online in a similar timeframe.

#### What's going on with Bess in Canada?

Elsewhere in Canada, other BESS-related advancements have been pouring in. In May, the government of Ontario completed the largest battery storage procurement in Canadian history. It secured 2,195 MW from ten projects ranging in size from 9 MW to 390 MW.

Within Canada, all energy storage projects currently under construction are BESS. Proposed and under-construction projects have a power range between 1 MW and 411 MW, ...
