

Do you need a power plug in the Maldives?

In the Maldives, power plugs and sockets of type D and type G are mainly used. For most travelers from regions where these types are not standard, it's advisable to carry a universal power plug adapter that can accommodate these types. This ensures you can charge your devices seamlessly no matter where you are in the Maldives.

Do I need a voltage converter in Maldives?

If your device or power adapter is not dual voltage or you are unsure, and the voltage and/or frequency in Maldives differs from your own country, you should use a voltage converter when plugging in your devices and power adapters in Maldives. What power plug types and electrical outlets are used in Malé?

What type of power sockets are on the Maldives?

The power sockets on the Maldives are of type D and G. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter on the Maldives.

Do I need a travel adapter in Maldives?

Maldives uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C,D,G,J,K &L (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs,you don't need a travel adapter. Are the electrical outlets and power plugs in your country different? Then you will need a travel adapter.

Do the Maldives use the same plugs as the US?

No,the Maldives does not use the same plug types as the US. You will need an adapter for Type A or B American plugs to fit Type D,G,J,K,or L sockets used in the Maldives. Are type D and G plugs compatible with the electrical sockets in the Maldives? Yes,Type D and G plugs are compatible with the electrical sockets in the Maldives.

Can you use a charger in Maldives?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Maldives outlet. Maldives uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C, D, G, J, K & L (see images).
