

Can a two-speed dual-clutch gearbox be used for electric vehicles?

Most electric vehicles today use gearboxes with multiple speeds. The transmission systems on traditional cars using internal combustion engines can be used for electric vehicles. What are the benefits of a dual clutch transmission?

The main benefits of dual clutch transmissions (DCTs) are: (i) a higher energy efficiencythan automatic transmission systems with torque converters; and (ii) the capability to fill the torque gap during gear shifts to allow seamless longitudinal acceleration profiles.

What is a dual-clutch transmission (DCT)?

Does a DCT transmit the same clutch torque?
