Can a single phase inverter be used on a 3 phase supply?

(Note to West Australians: If you want to use a single-phase inverter on a 3 phase supply, Western Power only allow up to a 3 kW inverter on one phase of a 3 phase supply, so you should get a 3 phase inverter.) If the inverter trips you lose all your solar generation until the inverter is manually or automatically reset.

However, network operators will not allow an imbalance across the phases, you'll either have to install three single-phase inverters for each phase, or one three phase inverter that will work across all three phases.
