

Can 2mm glass be used in PV modules?

As per NREL,though,2-mm glass in PV modules does not yet meet the criteria for fully tempered safety glass. Other solutions may include increasing the surface compression in thinner glass to improve its fracture resistance.

Can tempered glass be used in PV modules?

Using high-quality tempered glass with surface compression levels that meet or exceed industry standards can be one possible solution. As per NREL,though,2-mm glass in PV modules does not yet meet the criteria for fully tempered safety glass.

Can PV module glass be used with metal frames?

PV module glass should never be in direct contactwith metal frames, as even small vibrations and movements can cause cracks over time. Additionally, debris such as sand and dust can become trapped between the frame and glass, leading to abrasion and micro-fractures.
