Canada's total wind, solar and storage installed capacity is now more than 24 GW, including over 18 GW of wind, more than 4 GW of utility-scale solar, 1+GW on-site solar, and 330 MW of energy storage. Canada's solar energy capacity (utility-scale and onsite) grew 92% in the past 5 years (2019-2024).

Does Canada have solar energy?

Canada's solar energy capacity (utility-scale and onsite) grew 92% from 2019 to 2024. Our wind energy capacity grew 35% during the same period. Our energy storage capacity grew 192% during that period. Canada has 341 wind energy projects producing power. Canada has 217 utility-scale solar energy projects producing power.

How many solar energy projects are there in Canada?

Canada now has 217 major solar energy projects producing power across the country. There are now nearly 96,000 onsite solar energy installations across Canada. What types of energy storage are available in Canada?
