

Why is Burundi launching a solar PV plant?

The pioneering 7.5 MW solar PV plant has increased Burundi's generation capacity by over 10%, and is the country's first substantial energy generation project to go online in over three decades, supplying clean power to tens of thousands of homes and businesses - just before the start of COP26. How much solar power is available in Burundi?

Hydropower: 1,700 MW of potential. 300 MW are economically possible ("Burundi" 2022). Solar: Average daily solar insolation is 4-5 kWh/m2/day,indicating strong solar potential for Burundi ("Energy Profile Burundi" n.d.). There is a growing number of households,businesses,schools,and health clinics using distributed,off-grid solar.

Will Burundi's first grid-connected solar farm light up the country's energy system?

UK Minister for Energy, Clean Growth and Climate Change, Greg Hands, said: "Today's launch of Burundi's first grid-connected solar farm will light up the nation's energy system. It will strengthen the national grid supply and propel forward a promising future for the country in clean, green energy.

What is the primary energy supply in Burundi?

The remainder of the primary energy supply is from oil("Burundi Energy Profile" 2021). However,a majority (98%) of the renewable energy supply in Burundi is bioenergy. The remainder of the renewable energy supply is hydroelectric, and solar power ("Burundi Energy Profile" 2021).
