

Do mobile phones need a base station?

Mobile phones and other mobile devices require a network of base stations in order to function. The base station antennas transmit and receive RF (radio frequency) signals, or radio waves, to and from mobile phones near the base station. Without these radio waves, mobile communications would not be possible.

How much exposure can a radio base station have?

On the ground,in houses,and other places where people reside,the exposure levels from radio base stations are normally below 1 percent of the limits. Only in the close vicinity of the antennas can the exposure limits sometimes be exceeded.

How do base stations work?

Base stations transmit and receive radio wavesto connect the users of mobile phones and other devices to mobile communications networks. The strength of the radio waves from base station antennas reduces rapidly with increasing distance and the levels at locations where the public can be exposed tend to be small.

Are mobile phones dangerous to people living near base stations?

In the UK,the Independent Expert Group on Mobile Phones (IEGMP) concluded in its 2000 report that the balance of evidence indicates that there is no general riskto the health of people living near base stations on the basis that exposures are expected to be small fractions of guidelines.

How far away from a mobile tower is EMF radiation strongest?

The first "radiation lobe" (the beam of the mobile tower) lands around 150ft, which is where EMF radiation is strongest. After that, there's a direct correlation between distance and radiation intensity. So, the farther away from the tower you are, the less radiation you're exposed to.

How can a base station be regulated?

Control of exposures occurs through product safety legislation, health and safety legislation and planning policy. These regulatory areas all consider the international guidelines. With some of the larger and more powerful base stations, there can be regions around the antennas within which the guideline levels can be exceeded.
