Denmark will construct one of the world's first energy islands,utilizing its abundant wind energy resources in the North and Baltic Seas. These energy islands will form a crucial part of a hub-and-spoke grid,facilitating smart electricity distribution between regions across the two seas.

Why is Denmark launching an artificial energy island?

The approval of the artificial energy island comes months after Denmark announced that it wouldhalt its search for oil and gas in the North Sea. It also coincides with plans by the EU to rely almost entirely on renewable energy within a decade and increase its offshore wind energy capacity 25-fold.

Why is Denmark putting the planned construction of an island on hold?

The Danish government has decided to put the planned construction of an island just for the production of renewable energyon hold. The island was planned 15 kilometres south of the strategically situated island of Bornholm in the Baltic Sea.

Who owns Denmark's electricity?

The Danish Statewill be the majority owner and own at least 50.1 percent of the island. The large amount of electricity sourced from the island will have implications on Denmark's security of supply. Parts of the electrotechnical facility will therefore constitute critical infrastructure.

How much does a wind turbine project cost in Denmark?

It will serve as a hub for 200 giant offshore wind turbines. It is the biggest construction project in Danish history, costing an estimated 210bn kroner (£24bn; EUR28bn: \$34bn). Situated 80km (50 miles) out to sea, the artificial island would be at least half-owned by the state but partly by the private sector.

How do wind farms work in Denmark?

Today,we harness the energy from strong ocean winds via isolated offshore wind farms that supply electricity directly to the Danish electricity grid. With these energy islands,the wind turbines can be placed further away from the coast and distribute the power they generate between several countries more efficiently.
