What is the power sector investment plan in PNG?

TRANSFORMER CAPACITY EXPANSION PLAN Most new power sector investment in PNG over the next 10 years is expected to be organized around projects identified in the LCPDP (generation and transmission investments on the POM and Ramu grids) and the NEROP (electrification nationwide).

Why does PNG have a low electricity consumption?

Most provincial centers are supplied entirely through diesel generation, resulting in high generation costs and low power supply quality. Hence, PNG's per capita electricity consumption is among the lowest globally.

Does Papua New Guinea have oil & gas extraction projects?

According to Global Energy Monitor's Global Oil and Gas Extraction Tracker (March 2024 release), Papua New Guinea has five discovered oil and gas extraction projects: the Pasca Oil and Gas Field, the Stanley Oil and Gas Field, the Kutubu Oil Project, the P'nyang Gas Field, and the Elk-Antelope Gas Field.

How much funding is needed for PNG's Power Sector?

Based on the LCPDP and NEROP, more than USD 700 million of additional funding is required to finance PNG's power sector expansion costs until 2030. Separately, the total addressable market (i.e., total potential revenue) for the off-grid sector (both mini-grids and standalone solar products) is approximately USD 800 million.
