How much power does an inverter use?

When you include the idle power consumption of the inverter with it's conversion inefficiency while powering small loads,50-150W,55-70% efficient is a good number. Many units have a "low power" option where idle power consumption is decreased; however,those are only useful if you have NO loads whatsoever on the unit.

Why do inverters consume a lot of idle power?

The dominate idle consumption on inverters should be caused by the power consumed switching the high frequency power MOSFET gate input capacitance. The larger the inverter VA rating, the greater the sum total of MOSFET input capacitance to chop on and off. There are a couple of other things impacting idle power, primarily because of poor design.

Bigger inverters generally use more power, even when not in use. However, more efficient inverters turn more sunlight into usable power, needing less extra power.
