When charging, the protection board will monitor the voltage of each string of the battery pack in real-time, as long as one of the strings reaches the overcharge protection value (the default charging voltage is $3.75V \pm 0.05V$), the protection board will cut off the power supply, and the entire set of lithium batteries will stop charging.
