What is a cellular base station?

A cell site, cell phone tower, cell base tower, or cellular base station is a cellular -enabled mobile device sitewhere antennas and electronic communications equipment are placed (typically on a radio mast, tower, or other raised structure) to create a cell, or adjacent cells, in a cellular network.

How does a wireless device communicate with a base station?

When a wireless device, such as a mobile phone, communicates with a base station, the device sends a signal to the base station, which converts the signal into digital form and sends it to the network. Similarly, when the network sends data to the device, the base station converts the digital data into a wireless signal that the device can receive.
