

How much power does a cellular base station use?

This problem exists particularly among the mobile telephony towers in rural areas, that lack quality grid power supply. A cellular base station can use anywhere from 1 to 5 kW power per hourdepending upon the number of transceivers attached to the base station, the age of cell towers, and energy needed for air conditioning.

What is a mobile phone base station?

A mobile phone base station is a telecommunications infrastructure used to send and receive RF signals from mobile phones. The frequencies used typically range from 900 MHz to 2.45 GHz, with powers varying from 1 W for indoor antennas to 40 W for those at high elevations.

Base station antenna elements are usually less than ten centimeters (about 4 inches) high, but they are often mounted on towers with heights of about a meter (about 3 feet) to overcome obstacles, such as trees, hills, or tall buildings, and ensure a clear line of sight to cell phones.
