Required solar panel output = 30 kWh / 5 hours = 6 kW. Step- 4 Consider Climate Changes: To account for efficiency losses and weather conditions, add a buffer to your solar panel output requirements. Usually, it is 1.2 to 1.5 which is multiplied by the desired output.
