

How many amps does a 3000W inverter draw?

Inverter Current = 1000 & #247; 12 = 83.33 Amps So,the inverter draws 83.33 amps from a 12V battery. Inverter Current = 3000 & #247; 24 = 125 AmpsSo,a 3000W inverter on a 24V system pulls 125 amps from the battery. Inverter Current = 5000 & #247; 48 = 104.17 Amps The current drawn is approximately 104.17 amps.

How do you calculate dc current from an inverter?
