

How much power does a 24V inverter draw?

To find out how much power an inverter draws without any load, multiply the battery voltage by the inverter no load current draw. A 1000 watt 24V inverter with a 0.4 no load current has a power consumption of 9.6 watts. $24V \times 0.4 = 9.6$ watts If you want to figure out the no load current in amps, divide the watts consumption by the battery voltage.
