

Does Latvia have a 330 kV power network?

Latvia's 330 kV power networkrepresents the middle point of the energy system of the Baltic states between its northern and southern parts. All 330 kV substations, except for " Daugavpils ", have a dual power supply. The 110 kV network has a circle scheme. The majority of the 110 kV substations have two transformers and a dual power supply.

#### How much energy does Latvia use?

Latvia is a net energy importer. Primary energy use in Latvia was 49 TWh,or 22 TWh per million persons in 2009. In 2018, electricity consumption per capita was 3731 kWh. Latvia has adopted the EU target to produce 50% of its energy from renewable sources by 2030.

#### What are the different types of energy sources in Latvia?

Renewable energy here is the sum of hydropower, wind, solar, geothermal, modern biomass and wave and tidal energy. Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important energy source in lower-income settings. What is the difference between electricity transmission and electricity distribution in Latvia?

Electricity transmission in Latvia is carried out by a single transmission system operator - JSC "Augstsprieguma tikls", while electricity distribution - by 11 distribution system operators (List of licences of distribution system operators) of which JSC "Sadales tikls" supplies electricity to 99% of the power users.

#### How does privatization affect Latvia's telecommunications network?

In addition,3 hydroelectric dams along Latvia's largest river, the Daugava, add to the power supply, but still electricity is imported to feed this most industrialized Baltic State. Privatization has caused a reconstruction in Latvia's telecommunications network.

#### Who generates electricity in Latvia?

Electricity in Latvia is generated by the following companies which are listed in the Electricity producer register. The largest electricity generator in Latvia is JSC "Latvenergo". The Regulator reviews submissions and complaints about the provision of public services. More information is available in Latvian.
