

How much electricity does Lesotho produce?

Lesotho produces about 72 MWfrom hydropower (Meula). It has about 150 MW peak power and imports more than 70 MW mainly from Mozambique (29% of peak demand) and 20% of its peak demand from South Africa. The electricity supply accounts only for +-50% in the energy mix.

Who controls the energy sector in Lesotho?

There are other Ministries or agencies with overarching influence over the energy sector: Ministry of Development Planning; Ministry of Finance; Ministry of Mining; Ministry of Public Works and Transport; Water Commission; and Lesotho Revenue Authority. LEC is wholly owned by the Government of Lesotho (GoL). The Basotho Enterprises Development Corporation (BEDCO) is a parastatal of the Government of Lesotho.

Who regulates urban water and sewerage services in Lesotho?

In 2007 the Government decided that the Lesotho Electricity Authority (LEA) should be transformed to be a multi-sector regulatory body assuming additional powers to regulate urban water and sewerage services in the country. LEWAofficially started regulating both electricity and urban water and sewerage services sector on May,2013.
