

How do I pick up a base station/repeater?

DO NOT pick up the base station/repeater by holding the Preselector (if so equipped). Use the handles on the front of the base station/repeater, or the Power Supply and Power Amplifier casings when picking up the base station/repeater. Remove the station front bezel from its chassis locking clip by carefully pulling it forward.

How to connect a ham radio to a power supply?

Connect the wires. Attach the positive wire from your power supply to the positive terminal on your ham radio. Ensure it's connected securely using suitable connectors like ring terminals or Powerpole connectors. Similarly, connect the negative wire from your power supply to the negative terminal on your ham radio. 5. Ensure proper grounding.

How do I connect a battery to a base station/repeater?

Batteries must be connected to the base station/repeater through an Argus Technologies Battery Reverting Charger, Model #010-523-20 (Motorola Model #L1884) for 24 V charging systems. These systems were developed specifically for this interface and tested by Motorola for proper base station/repeater operation.

What is a power supply module?

A Power Supply Module is used in a base station/repeater with a Power Amplifier Module(e.g. rated at 100 W output power). The model generates the +5.1 V,+14.2 V,and +28.6 V operating voltages for the base station/repeater modules. These modules have power factor correction and include a connection for battery backup.

How do I optimize a base station/repeater?

Optimizing is performed through the Customer Programming Software(CPS) with the kit number,(NAG: RVN5115,EMEA/ANZ: GMVN5141,APAC: PMVN4130) and a USB cable (NAG: CLN8665A,EMEA/APAC: DDN9957) is required. After the base station/repeater is operational,the base station/repeater's codeplug data must be copied to a PC-compatible computer.

Do mtr3000 base stations/repeaters need power factor correction?

Accordingly, power factor correction is necessary for MTR3000 base stations/repeaters. Power Supply model DLN6707 has internal power factor correction. The DC source operates from 21.6 VDC to 32 VDC. This DC source must be located in the same building as the base station/repeater, and it must meet the requirements of a SELV circuit.

The base station/repeater is equipped with a switching power supply, this assembly operates from 85 VAC to 264 VAC at 47 to 63 Hz AC input power. A standard 3-prong line cord is supplied to ...
