What is gravity-based energy storage?

Baud Resources, an IIT Kanpur incubated deep-tech startup, has developed a novel approach to gravity-based energy storage that operates on gravitational potential energy without the need for water, dams or hills, unlike pumped hydro storage. The mechanism can be implemented in any location (plains, desert or sub-zero climate).

How does a solid gravity energy storage system work?

In a solid gravity energy storage system, heavy objects such as concrete blocks are lifted against the earth's gravitational field through electromechanical equipment. The electrical power that drives the electromechanical equipment to lift the weight to a certain height is stored as gravitational potential energy.

What is gravity storage vs pumped hydro storage?

Compared to pumped hydro storage, the gravity storage design also allows co-location with existing solar and wind plants. It can be delivered at places with scarce water sources or sub-zero climates, where pumped hydro storage may not be a feasible or efficient option.
