Will Indonesia build a 100 GW solar power plant?

Jakarta, August 7, 2025 - Indonesia will build a 100 Gigawatt (GW) Solar Power Plant (PLTS). The program plans to build 80 GW of solar power plants and 320 GWh of Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) to be managed by the Merah Putih Village Cooperative (KDMP) in 80,000 villages, and 20 GW of Centralized solar power plants.

How much solar power can Indonesia produce?

It stands out in Southeast Asia with an estimated capacity to produce up to 7,715 GW of solar power - a potential that far exceeds many of its neighbors. To harness this potential, the Indonesian government has set ambitious goals, aiming to boost the country's solar energy capacity to 6.5 GW by 2025 and to 17.6 GW by 2035.

How important is solar energy in Indonesia?

Despite its vast potential, solar energy currently plays a minor role in Indonesia's energy mix. As of 2022, solar power accounted for less than 1% of the country's total energy capacity (MEMR, 2022).
