This work investigates the specific response of a utility-scale PV inverter to grid voltage phase shift-type disturbances which sometimes occur during grid fault events. The role of the PV inverter's phase-locked-loop (PLL) is identified as important to modeling the response.

Why is phase-shift power modulation used in a microinverter?

Frequency modulation in the resonant circuit causes an unpredictable noise spectrum, resulting in more complex filtering of output voltage and poor utilization of magnetic components. Hence, phase-shift power modulation is used to control power output of this microinverter.

What is phase shift angle dspwm?
