

How much solar energy does Mozambique have?

Mozambique has a potential solar energy yield estimated between 1,785 and 2,206 kWh/m2/year,resulting in a solar energy potential of 23,000GWh/year. In August 2019,the first grid-ready solar power station,the 40 megawatts Mocuba Solar Power Station,in Mocuba District,Zambezia Province,achieved commercial commissioning.

When did Globeleq & Mozambique launch a solar power plant?

Our solar power plant in Cuamba was inaugurated in September of 2023. It marked another milestone for Globeleq and Mozambique, as it was the first IPP to integrate a utility-scale energy storage system.

Is battery storage a key technology for Mozambique's future?

Globelequeses battery storage as a key technology for Mozambique's future. Storage costs are expected to continue decreasing, so those systems will become more competitive and will be able to contribute more.

Who built Mozambique's first large-scale solar power plant?

Capital and expertise from Scatec Solar, KLP and Norfundenabled the construction of Mozambique's first large-scale solar power plant. Central Solar de Mocuba (CESOM) provides over 79 GWh of electricity annually, which is equivalent to the electricity consumption of more than 170,000 households in Mozambique.

How will Mozambique's power plant's strategic location affect the grid?

The project's strategic location will reduce energy transmission losses and improve the security of energy supply in northern Mozambique and stabilize the grid. It is estimated that the power plant's connection to the EDM grid will result in a seven percent improvement in the network default level.

What does Cuamba solar mean for Mozambique?

The plant is the first IPP in Mozambique to integrate a utility-scale energy storage systemand includes an upgrade to the existing Cuamba substation. The Cuamba Solar plant supplies enough power for 21,800 consumers over the project's life and is expected to avoid the equivalent of more than 172,000 tonnes of CO2 emissions
