

How does a power station work in North Korea?

The No. 2 station feeds from the water that flows through the dam and the larger station, and this arrangement, according to North Korean media, means it "can operate a generator even in the dry season by using the water from the army-people power station and mountain streams."

How many power plants are in North Korea?

Collectively,the five power plantscan generate 134 megawatts when at full capacity, which represents about 1.4 percent of North Korea's entire national electricity supply, according to estimates from the Nautilus Institute.
