Can a telecom line be carried on a power line?

Telecom lines will sometimes be carried on their own poles, separate from poles carrying power lines. These poles are typically smaller than power poles, with no electric equipment like transformers or insulators attached. CHELCO-owned power line poles will have a CHELCO pole number attached to it.

How do you read a residential utility pole diagram?

Identifying Components: The first step in reading a residential utility pole diagram is identifying the different components. Power lines are typically shown as solid lines, while communication cables are represented by dashed lines.

How much clearance between communication lines and electrical service lines?

Also, there should be 30 inches of clearance between communication lines and electrical service lines. Remember that minimum vertical clearances must be measured from the lowest point of the wire's droop.

Are residential electrical services pre-designed?

Some residential electrical services are pre-designed and have the information already available for you. For example, in custom home scenarios, it is common to have to gather information up front from the builder and/or homeowner.

What are the components of a residential utility pole?

Residential utility poles contain multiple components, including crossarms, insulators, transformers, and communication attachments. The crossarms provide a platform for the cables and wires to be mounted, while the insulators prevent electricity from being conducted to the pole itself.

How will the 2020 NEC cycle affect residential electrical services?

The 2020 NEC cycle had an additional change that will impact residential electrical service installations. New section 230.67 requires all dwelling unit electrical services to have a surge protective device (SPD) installed.
