#### Which mobile operators are offering 5G SA Services?

According to Opensignal's findings, as of mid-June, three of its four mobile operators--Singtel, M1, and StarHub--are now offering commercial 5G SA services. Singtel leads with SA download speeds reaching around 400Mbps, topping all operators in the market.
