

#### Should inverter AC be turned off when not in use?

#### What happens if the inverter goes out?

The power goes out and your appliances cease to run. You can always turn the inverter back on but that can take time. And most appliances do not like being turned on and off. By leaving the inverter on,the system can automatically switch to it when shore power ceases.

#### Can I Leave my inverter on all the time?

Yes, you can leave your inverter ON all the time if it's working under the rated capacity. Should I leave my inverter on all the time? It depends on your use of energy. If you have the appliance connected to the inverter, it might need the power source to function, especially when using the inverter in the RV or traveling in remote places.
