

What is a solar photovoltaic & how does it work?

The job of solar photovoltaics (PV) is to harness sunlight to generate electricity- which is solar energy or solar power. In order to do this, solar photovoltaic devices, called solar cell, are used, which are contained within solar panels, also called photovoltaic panels, or modules.

#### What is a photovoltaic system?

Photovoltaics (PV): Devices that convert solar energy into electricity using semiconductors(this conversion is called the photovoltaic effect). Solar panels are photovoltaics and make up a PV system. Power output/rating: The number of watts a solar panel produces in ideal conditions.

#### How much power does a photovoltaic panel produce?

This means the photovoltaic panel output can,in theory, exceed 400 wattsof power. The more efficient the panel is at turning sunlight into energy, the higher the output. Most solar panels with 60 solar cells (this can be also called as photovoltaic cell) generate between 270 and 300 watts solar power.

A photovoltaic (PV) cell,commonly called a solar cell, is a nonmechanical device that converts sunlight directly into electricity. Some PV cells can convert artificial light into electricity. Sunlight is composed of photons, or particles of solar energy.
