What is the economic value of energy storage?

One study found that the economic value of energy storage in the U.S. is \$228B over a 10 year period. 27 Lithium-ion batteries are one of the fastest-growing energy storage technologies 30 due to their high energy density, high power, near 100% efficiency, and low self-discharge 31. The U.S. has 1.1 Mt of lithium reserves, 4% of global reserves. 32

Why is energy storage more expensive than alternative technologies?

High capital cost and low energy density make the unit cost of energy stored (\$/kWh) more expensive than alternative technologies. Long duration energy storage traditionally favors technologies with low self-discharge that cost less per unit of energy stored.

What are battery storage projects?

Most of the battery storage projects that ISOs/RTOs develop are for short-term energy storage and are not built to replace the traditional grid. Most of these facilities use lithium-ion batteries, which provide enough energy to shore up the local grid for approximately four hours or less.
